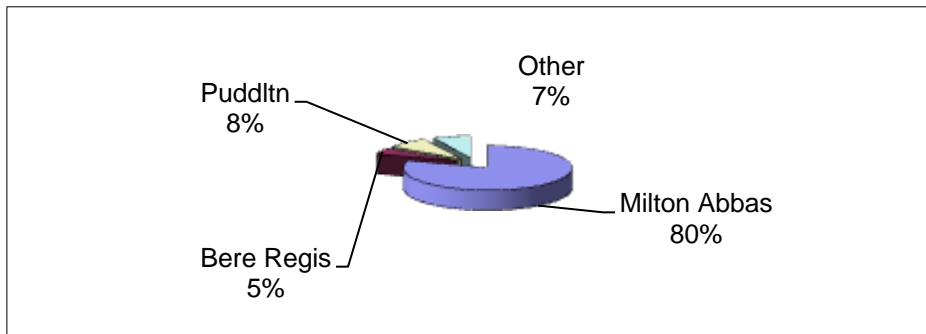

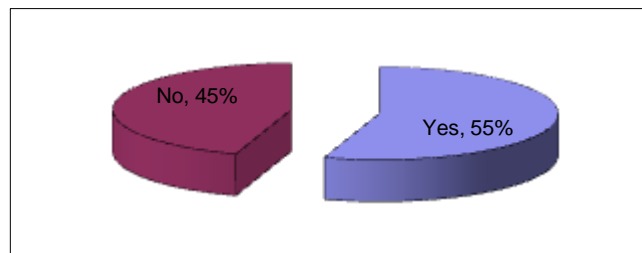

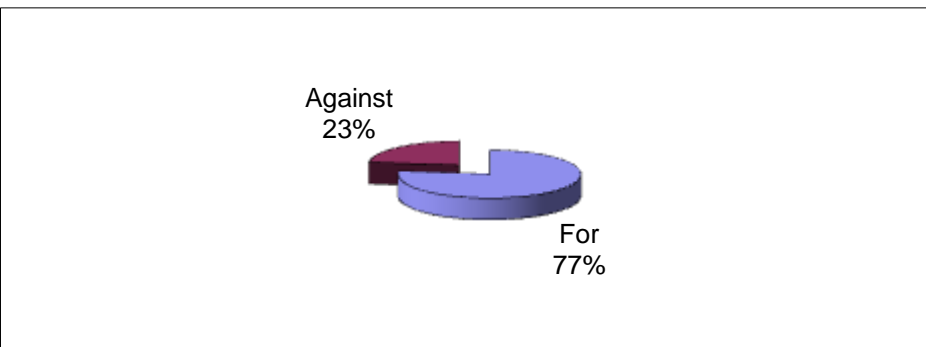


3.3 Distance travelled to Dentist

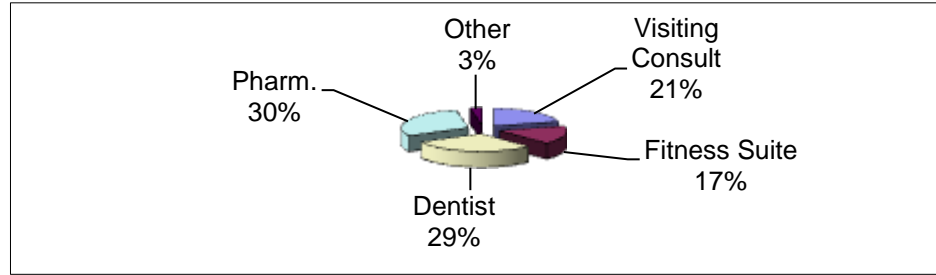
3.5 For/Against an enlarged Health Centre in the Village

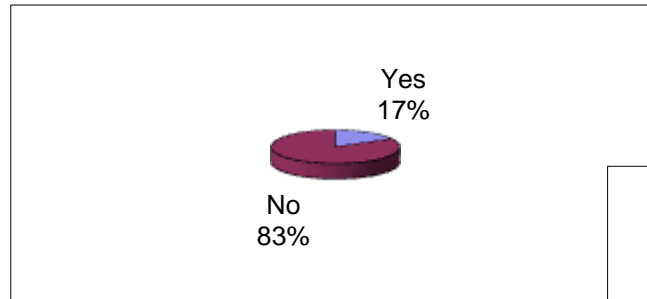

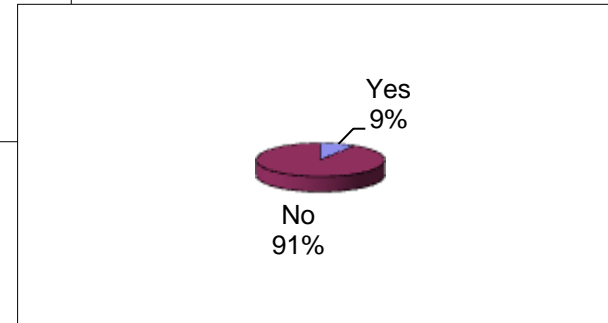

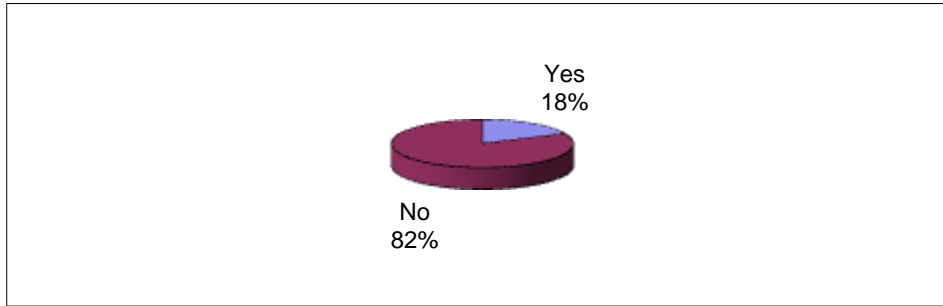

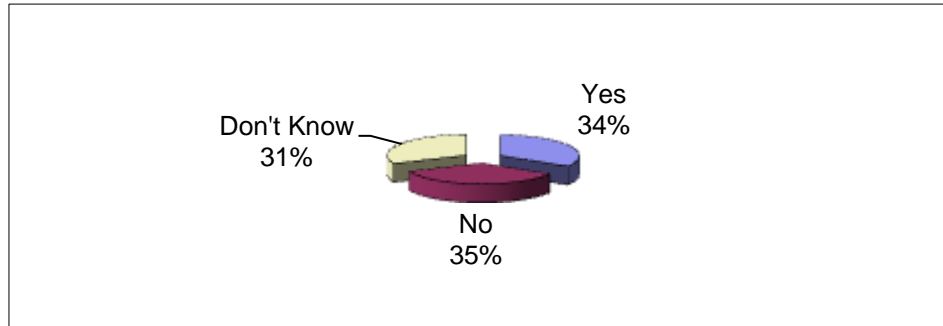

3.13 Level of satisfaction with the way housing has developed in the last 20 years in the Parish

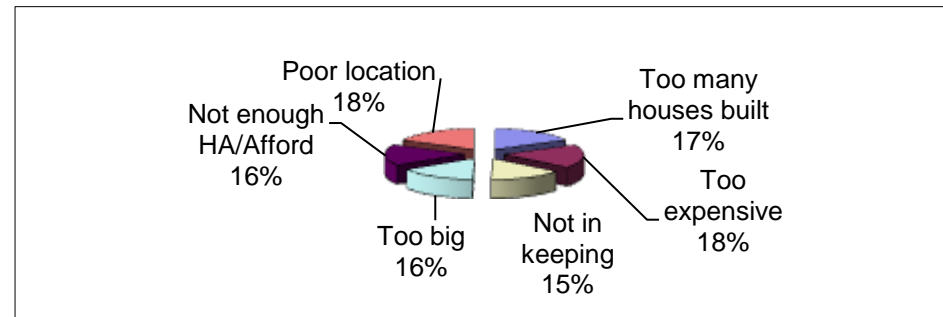

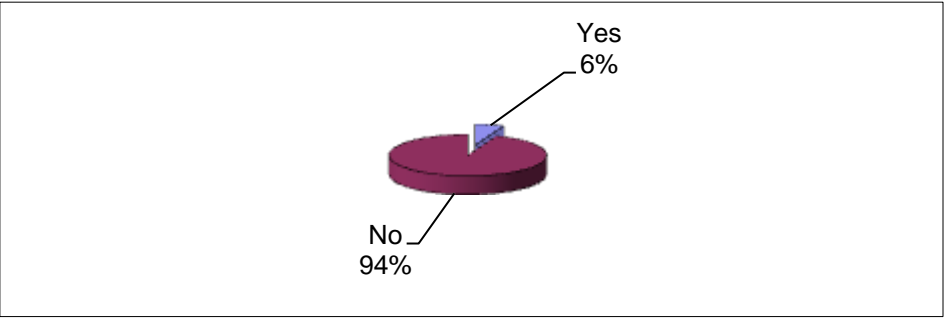

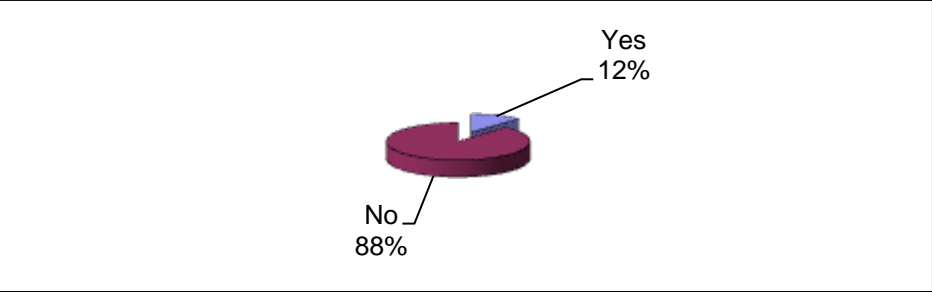
3.15 Those who have seriously considered leaving the Village recently for lack of affordable housing?

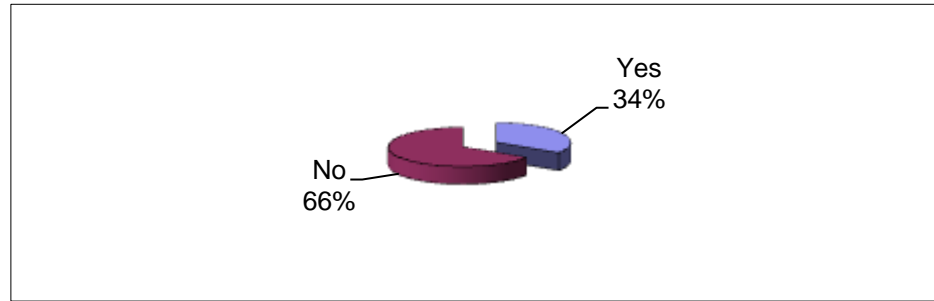
3.16 Those having to live in a household because who cannot afford to move out to their own home?

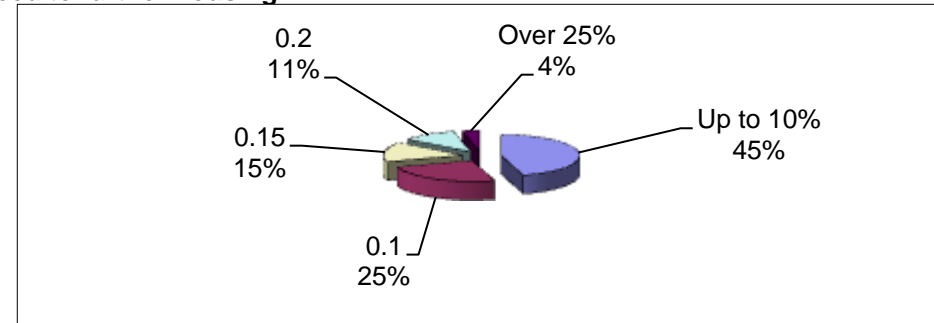
3.17 Should the Village should have further housing development in the next 10 years
